Private Melvin Joseph Benner, Canadian Army (See List No. 2), killed during operational duty in England, April 20, 1944.

Private William Robertson Carr, Canadian Army, (See List No. 2), now reported wounded in action overseas.

Lieutenant Tom Walker Gage, U.S. Army Air Corps, (See List No. 2), killed in air operations at Presque Isle, Maine, March 11, 1944.

Lieutenant James Robert Henderson, Canadian Army, (See List No. 1), killed in action in Italy Aug. 31, 1944.

Sergeant John C. Landon, Royal Air Force, (See List No. 4), reported missing in operations over Germany in March, 1944, now presumed dead.

Flight Sergeant Ernest Bruce Sutherland, Royal Canadian Air Force, (See List No. 1), reported missing in operations over Germany, Jan. 27, 1944, now officially reported prisoner of war in Germany.

\*Private George Willis Pribble, U.S. Army, killed in action in the invasion of Saipan about June 15, 1944.
