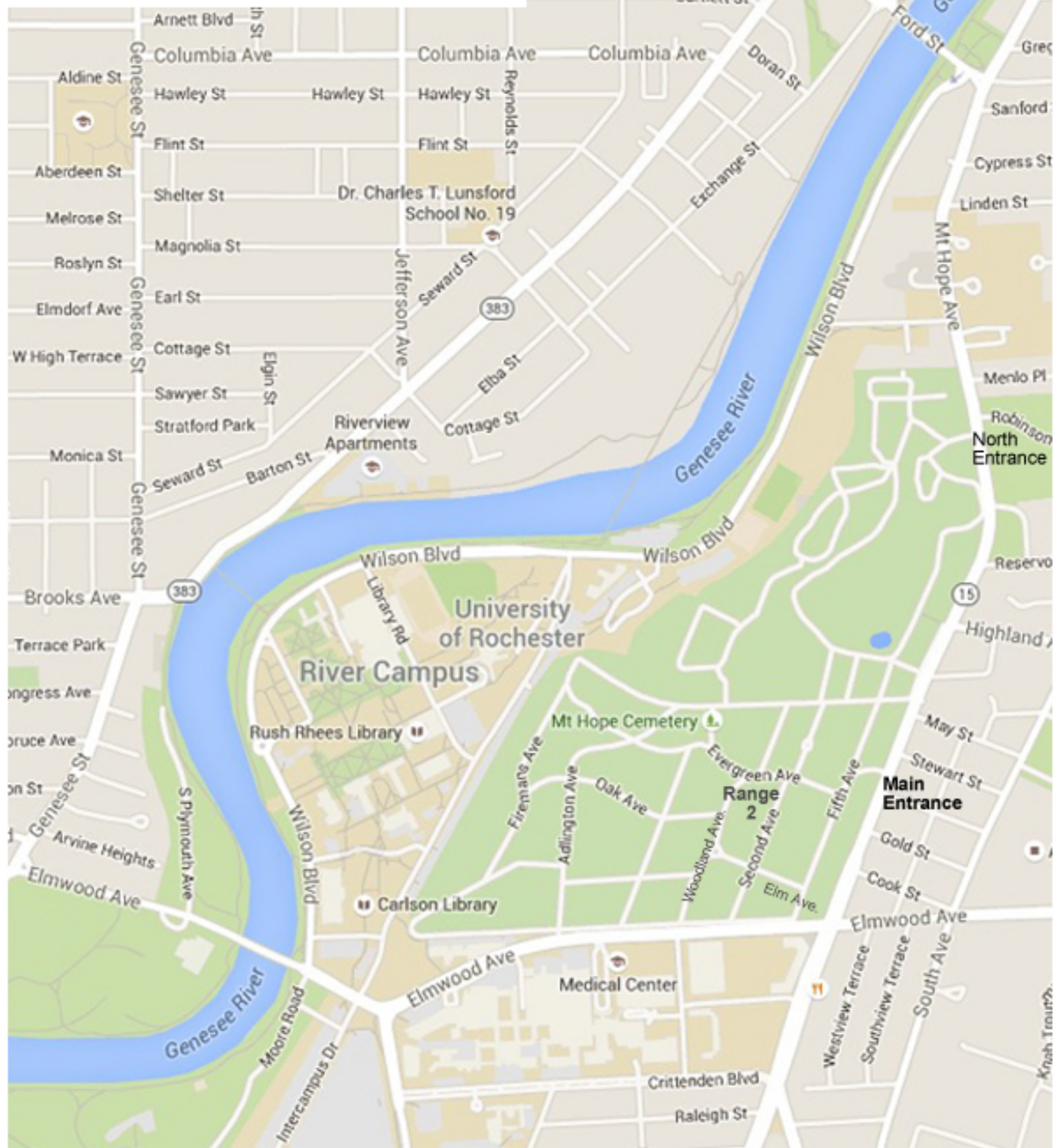


Mt. Hope Cemetery
